Photoautotrophs use energy from the sun to carry out photosynthesis; CO2 is also used.

Recall:

S = vt

 $S = 2\pi r$ (for a circle)

5 revolutions per second translates to 1 revolution every 0.20 seconds.

Equate both equations:

$$2\pi r = vt$$

$$2\pi(1) = v(0.20)$$

$$v = 31.4 \text{ m/s}$$

$$a = v^2 / r = (31.4)^2 / 1 = 986 \text{ m/s}^2$$



$$F = ma$$

$$F = (0.150 \text{ kg})(986 \text{ m/s}^2) = 148 \text{ N}$$







Contact Force Between 4 kg and 6 kg:

F = ma

F = (6)(1.7)

F = 10.2 N

Which carbanion is the most stable?

Solution:

Carbanion stability is opposite that of carbocation stability. For carbanions: methyl > 1° > 2° > 3° . Choice C is a 1° carbanion, hence the most stable.

[Alkyl groups donate electrons, hence 3° would have 3 groups donating electrons; this would increase the negative charge and destabilize the specie].




